The Sir Walter Greenart Garden, designed by Daniel Tyrrell Landscapes ([www.danieltyrrell.com.au](http://www.danieltyrrell.com.au)) fused some of the finer elements of a luxury living space with a family-friendly garden design. The garden featured rock gabion walls, a lush area of lawn, steel pathways, a plunge pool and an undercover entertainment area — a fresh version of the resort style, but with a family angle. Swathes of colourful planting softened the hard edges creating lots of interest, while the expanse of lawn provided a versatile area for play.
